
Head Start Gift Project 2020

Fleece blankets are also acceptable. I will see about arranging a fabric exchange and sewing days to get this going.

Zogg Fire Quilt Drive

QSR Quilters,

We want to take this opportunity again to thank everyone for all of their efforts to provide quilts for the victims who lost their homes in the Zogg Fire. Our members and quilters from around the U.S. donated quilts, quilt tops, pillowcases, quilting services, binding, making labels and sewing labels



for all of the quilts for the project. We were overwhelmed with everyone's generosity.

One Lutheran church in Illinois was hit by lightning this

past year and burned completely. When one of their members read a post about our project, she told the congregation, and several members of various ages, including the pastor, helped to make six quilts along with six handmade cards signed by all of them. She told me they realized the devastation brought to their church because of fire and wanted to help the victims of the Zogg Fire. The cornerstone to replace their 95 year old church has been laid and they blessed the quilts that were sent. It is stories such as this and the thank you's that came in from the various recipients that brought happiness to what has otherwise been a very strange year.



We have given out a total of 111 quilts to the 123 people identified as having lost homes. The others were not able to come to the December quilt giveaway and will be receiving quilts sometime in January.

We especially want to recognize the long arm machine quilters who fit our quilts in between

customer quilts during a very busy time of the year. We appreciate your time, effort, and talents to help us get these quilts finished!! Kudos to Patti Aberg for making a lot of new labels for us and to Sharon Jones for sewing most of them on.

We would also like to thank the volunteers who helped at the quilt giveaway in Igo and helped to provide assistance to the people selecting new quilts.



We also provided three quilts to the family members of the owners of La Cabana Restaurant whose home burned completely in early December.

We aren't done yet, so while we are still staying safely at home under our current purple tier of COVID restrictions, please consider making another philanthropic quilt. We really need some more that are more masculine in color and fabric choice for boys, teens, and adults. We still have several quilts that need binding and a label, so if you have time during the holidays to do that, please contact Cris for a safe porch pick-up/drop off, or email us at qsr.wecarequilts@gmail.com (the new Philanthropic email address).




