Non-judged entry fees are \$2.00 per item with a \$10.00 maximum fee (for 5 or more entries). Judged entry fees are *\$10.00 per quilt category/per member and **\$15.00 per quilt category/per non-member for each entry. [NOTE: Quilts submitted for judging in both Category A and Category B would pay* \$10/**\$15 for Category A plus *\$10/**\$15 for Category B) for a total entry fee of *\$20/**\$30. A quilt entered for judging the machine quilting may be submitted by either the quilt owner/piecer OR the machine quilter if quilted by someone other than the owner/piecer.

Quilt show guidelines are attached as well as posted on Quilters' Sew-Ciety of Redding, Inc. website at www.quilterssewciety.org. Two color photographs (3"x5" - digital printed on computer is acceptable) of quilt must be attached for each entry.

QUILTERS' SEW-CIETY OF REDDING, INC. QUILT SHOW GUIDELINES

Entry form must be received by 5:00 p.m., FRIDAY, APRIL 1, 2022 (no exceptions). Non-judged entry fees are \$2.00 per item with a \$10.00 maximum fee. Judged entry fees are *\$10.00 per quilt category/per member and **\$15.00 per quilt category/per non-member for each item. (NOTE: Quilts may be judged in two categories; i.e., both Category A and Category B. A quilt entered for judging the machine quilting may be submitted by either the quilt owner/piecer OR the machine quilter if quilted by someone other than the owner/piecer. Quilts submitted for judging in both Category A and Category B would pay* \$10/**\$15 for Category A plus *\$10/**\$15 for Category B.) Each entry must be submitted on a separate form.

- A quilt must be at least three layers—backing, filler, and top—held together primarily with stitching through all layers. In the art quilt, wearable art, and other techniques (such as wool) categories, entries must consist of at least two layers with sewing, stitching, tying, or fastening through the two layers. Edges should be finished appropriately.

Art Quilt/Original is an original that does not copy any other work, while an Art Quilt/Non-Original uses a pattern for entire quilt or elements of the quilt. The work must possess the basic structural characteristics of a quilt. It must be predominantly fabric or fabric-like material and must be composed of at least two full and distinct layers—a face layer and a backing layer. The face layer may be created by any or a combination of the following techniques:

- *Appliqué:* Hand, machine, raw edge, turned under, fusible, reverse
- *Color Application:* Hand-dyeing, tie dyeing, stamping, fabric painting
- *Embellishing:* Beading, buttons, cording, yarn, hand-stitching
- *Embroidery:* Hand, machine, free-standing
- *Machine Stitches:* Decorative, faux hand-quilt, zigzag, satin-stitch, twin needle
- *Piecing:* Straight, curved, strip
- *Quilting:* Hand, domestic or long-arm machine, free motion
- *Thread:* Thread painting, free motion embroidery, free motion quilting, bobbin-work, couching
- *Miscellaneous:* Needle felting, photo transfers, foiling, heat gun distressed fabric, Broderie Perse

The face and backing layers must be held together by hand- or machine-made functional quilting stitches or other elements that pierce all layers and are distributed throughout the surface of the work.

Modern quilts are primarily functional and inspired by modern design. Characteristics include, but are not limited to, geometric designs, the use of bold colors and prints, high contrast and graphic areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, and alternate grid work.

- Quilts previously entered in a Quilters' Sew-Ciety of Redding, Inc. quilt show or unfinished items will not be accepted.
- Entries (excluding miniatures) must have a 4" sleeve **sewn** across the back for hanging (**no pins**).
- Two color photographs (3"x5") – digital printed on computer is acceptable) must be included with quilt entry form and fees. The photographs submitted will not be returned. Photographs will be used for several purposes: To determine placement of quilt in the show area according to colors and design; verification of quilt entry at drop-off location; and further identification of quilt at pick up, if necessary. If entry is submitted online, you may upload a digital image and attach the color photograph of your entry.
- The Quilters' Sew-Ciety of Redding, Inc. reserves the right to limit the number of entries and their categories.
- Final placement of entries in a category will be at the discretion of the Quilt Show Chair, Registration Chair, and/or Judge.
- All exhibitors are responsible for insuring their articles. Every effort will be taken to safeguard submitted items, but neither Quilters' Sew-Ciety of Redding, Inc. or the Shasta District Fairgrounds can be held liable for loss or damage.
- Each entry must have an identification label. In addition, complete the paper label located on the bottom/front page of registration form and baste to the back of your entry in the lower right hand corner.
- You will be given receipts for your articles at the drop-off location. **These receipts will be your claim check at pick-up time**, approximately one hour after the quilt show closing. No article will be returned without a receipt.
- Registration may be completed online if both the Entry Form and Descriptive Information are included; however, registration will NOT be considered complete until registration fee is mailed and received by the **entry deadline of 5:00 p.m., FRIDAY, APRIL 1, 2022** (no exceptions).

ENTRY CHECKLIST

- There is a 4-inch sleeve sewn across the top for hanging.
- Two color photographs (3"x5") are attached.
- Descriptive information for entry (form on back of registration form) has been completed and is enclosed or has been emailed to danneandrews@charter.net.
- Check for entry fees is included (or mailed separately if registration is submitted online).
- Self-addressed, stamped envelope or email address – if entry receipt is requested.
- Mail entry form, photograph, fees, and descriptive information for **delivery by 5:00 p.m., FRIDAY, APRIL 1, 2022**.
- Quilt is clean and free of pet hair or strong odors, including smoke.
- Paper identification label from bottom of entry form is sewn to back lower right hand corner of quilt prior to drop off.
